PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Opened in 1883 to minister approximately 500 families in the East Side of Providence, RI, the original two-story wooden Church of the Holy Name of Jesus burned down in 1965. The church was reconstructed following the same design features of early Roman basilicas dating back to the fourth century including Corinthian pilasters, large barreled vaults, coffered ribs and a mosaic floor, which was updated with granite tile in various shades of gray, white and black. Antonio's Construction installed more than 1,600 square feet of granite using QUIKRETE® Thin Set™ Multi-Purpose.

QUIKRETE® Thin Set™ Multi-Purpose is a polymer-modified portland cement based Thin Set used as a bond coat for installation of tiles over interior or exterior horizontal or vertical surfaces that are rigid and non-flexing. It's available in white or gray, and requires no addition of latex or acrylic fortifier.

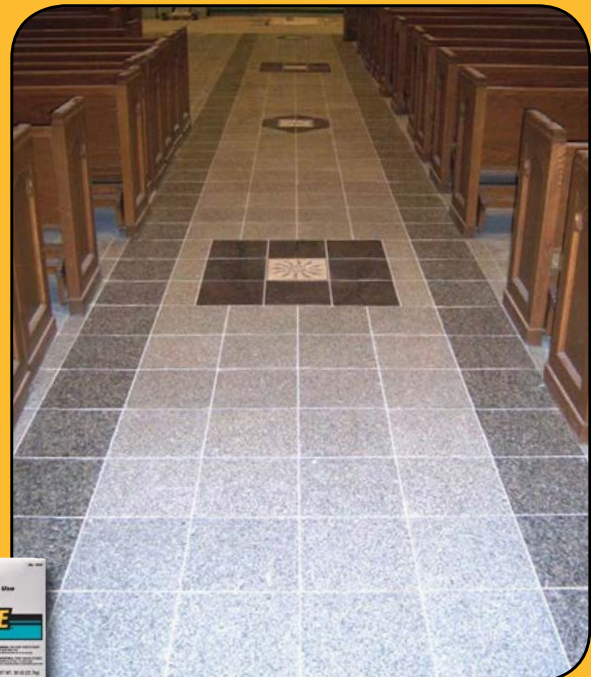
